EACH BULLYING KIT COMES WITH A CD THAT INCLUDES ALL THE INFORMATION IN THE BULLYING KIT.

Curriculum includes activities that teach students how to react when they see someone being bullied, when they are being bullied and when they are the person that is the bully. It helps students understand bullying from all three perspectives. Following is an example.

Learning Refusal Skills

- ⇒ Brainstorm and discuss different bullying refusal strategies;
- ⇒ ask students to use a different refusal strategy when encountering a bully;
- ⇒ encourage students to reflect at the end of the day about any bullying behavior they may have encountered for a 2 week period;
- ⇒ at the end of the timeframe, ask students to share their findings.

This activity allows students to recognize their own behaviors in dealing with bullying and provides them with strategies to use in the future.

Bullying Facts



- ⇒ The Supreme Court recently ruled that schools could be held liable for incidents of peer harassment.
- ⇒ 77% of 6 -12 graders in small mid-western towns have been bullied.
- ⇒ 37% of students do not feel safe in school.
- ⇒ 63% of students say they would learn more if they felt more safe at school.
- ⇒ National Education Association—160,000 children skip school each day because of intimidation.
- ⇒ In more than 3/4 of the cases, the attacker told a peer of his violent intentions.
- ⇒ More than 1/3 of teenage girls have experienced a violent dating relationship.
- ⇒ One in four identified bullies have a criminal record by the time they are 30.
