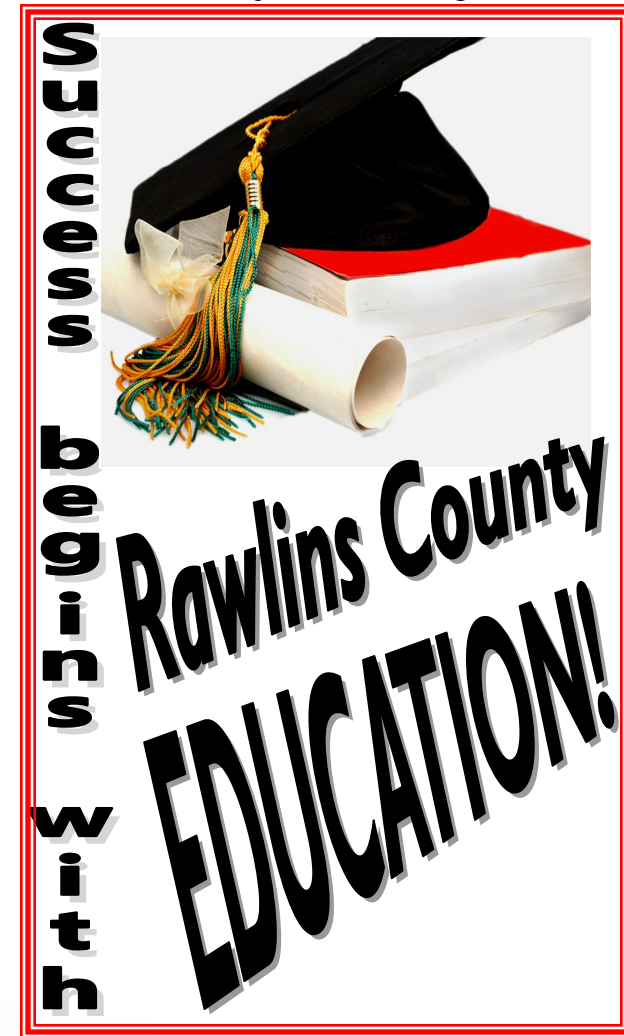

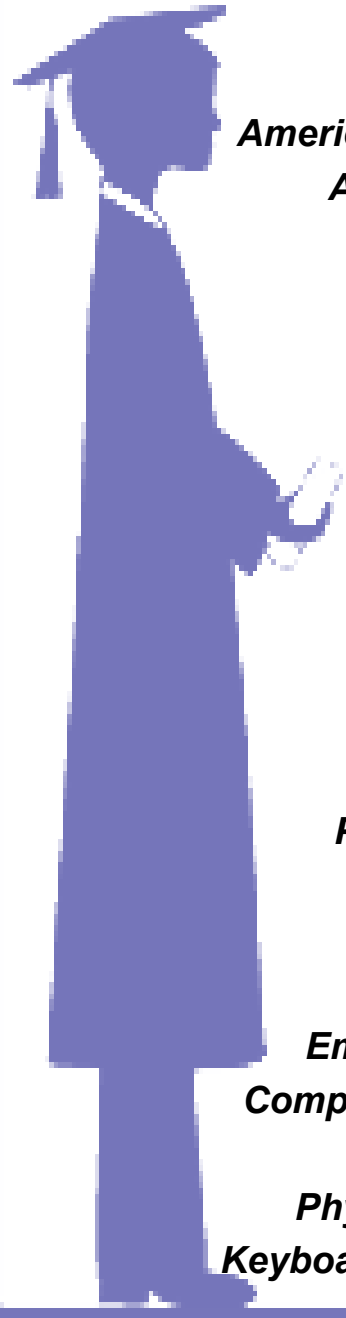
## How We Can Help

- The Adult Diploma Program is for people 18 or older who want to receive a high school diploma, **this is not a GED, it is an official high school diploma!**
- This Adult Diploma Program is available to adults 18 years or older and to students who have dropped out of school prior to age 18 with school district approval.
- Students will complete academic curriculum using computer-based course instruction and applications supplied by the Diploma Program.

## How long will it take to complete my course?

- Each student will advance at his or her own pace with a teacher available for assistance. Hours are flexible, you can attend class in the morning, afternoon, or evening.
- You can also access the classes via the internet and work at home as well. This frees your time so you can remain employed while earning your diploma.
- The length of time to receive your diploma depends on the number of credits you need. A highly motivated student can complete courses in much less time because the instruction is highly focused and the student may spend as much time on a given subject per day as he or she prefers.
- Upon completion of all required credits, you will be issued a High School Diploma from your area school district.
