- The Holcomb Community Learning Center Program is for people 18 or older who want to receive a high school diploma, **this is not a GED, it is an official high school diploma!**
- The Holcomb Community Learning Center Program is available to adults 18 years or older and to students who have dropped out of school prior to age 18 with school district approval.
- Students will complete academic curriculum using computer-based course instruction and applications supplied by the Diploma Program.

How long will it take to earn my diploma?

- Each student will advance at his or her own pace with a teacher available for assistance. Hours are flexible, you can attend class in the morning, afternoon, or evening.
