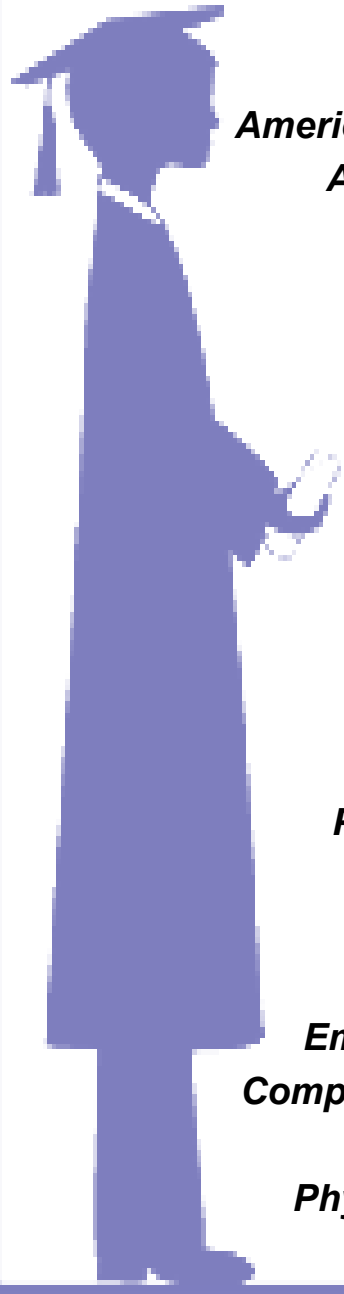
Sublette Adult Diploma Program

- The Sublette Adult Diploma Program is for people 18 or older who want to receive a high school diploma, and to students who have dropped out of school prior to age 18 with school district approval. **This is not a GED, it is an official high school diploma!**

- Students will complete academic curriculum using computer-based course instruction and applications supplied by the Diploma Program.

How long will it take to complete my course?
