Questions to ask yourself when preparing for your future:

What are you interested in?

What are your goals?

You may be interested in CAMP if:

You want to further your education.

You are not sure what your future career may be.

You want to gain life experiences before choosing a career.

You need financial help to pay for college expenses.



Reasons that you should want to be a CAMP student:

1. You will have the opportunity to meet new people and make new friends.
2. You will have the opportunity to attend cultural events.
3. You will have a personal mentor to help you successfully complete your classes.
4. You will be provided with some financial assistance.
5. You will receive academic support for the entire school year.

If you are interested in CAMP:

There are a few steps that you will need to take before applying for CAMP.

1. Check to see if you are eligible for the program.
2. Apply for government financial aid online at www.fafsa.gov
3. Apply for college at one of the four sites that we offer classes.
4. Receive your acceptance letter from the college.

5. Apply for CAMP.
